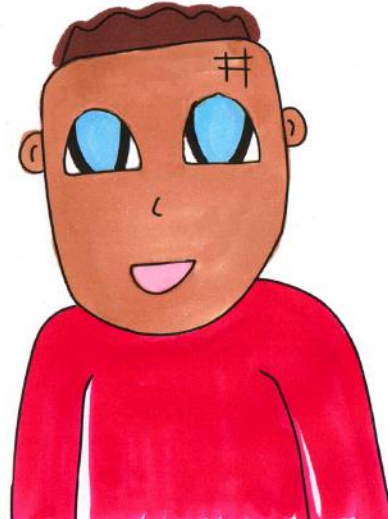

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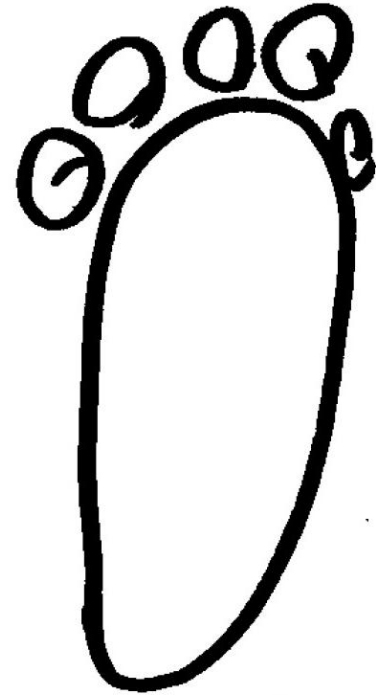
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Some kids are short,



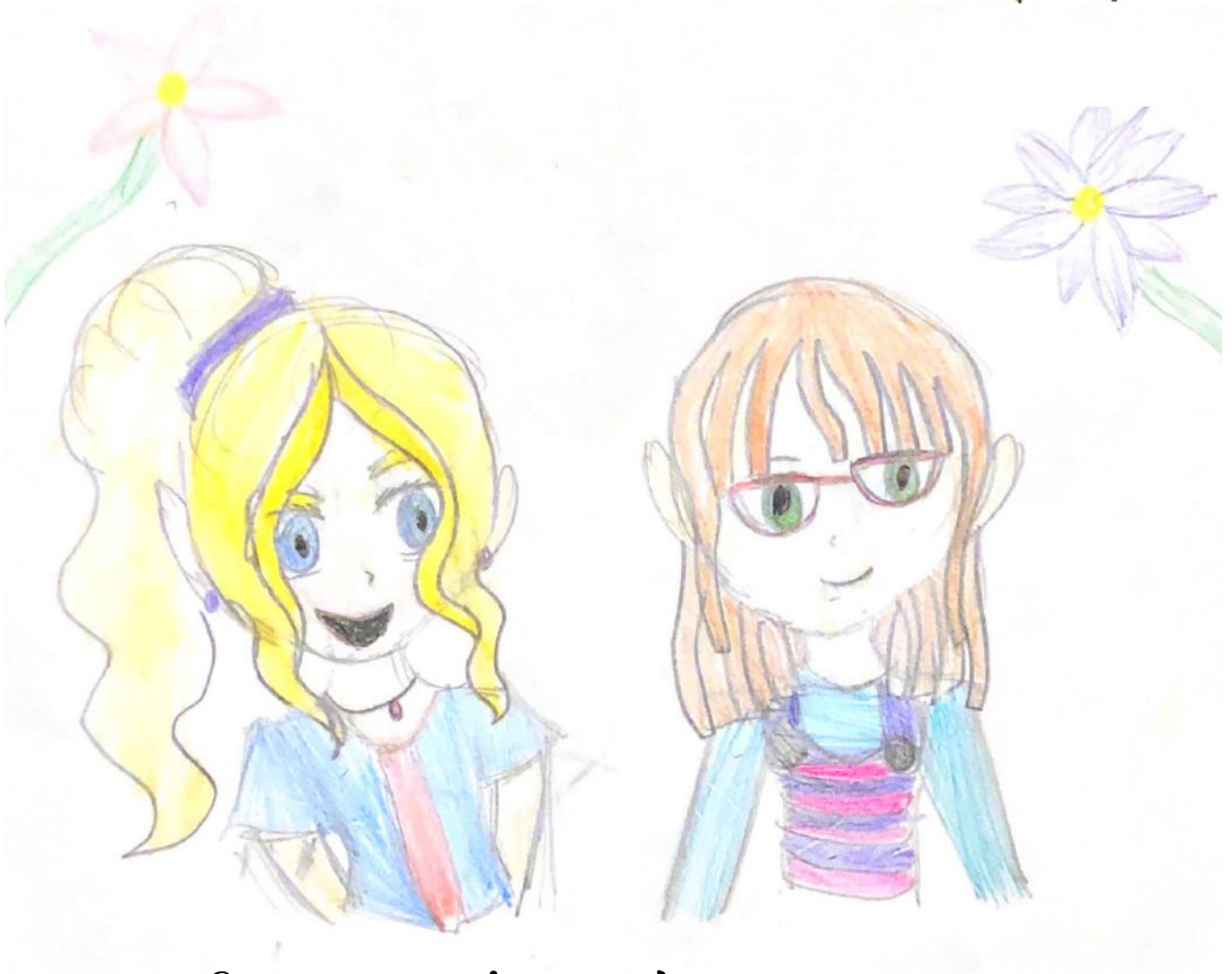
Some kids are tall,

or somewhere in between.

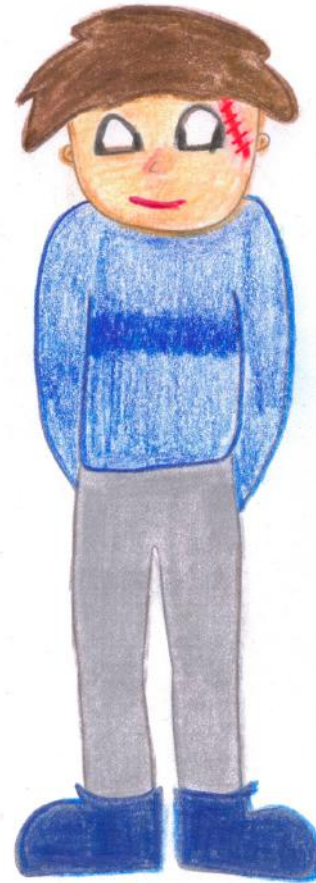


Some kids have freckles,

Some even have hair on their toes,

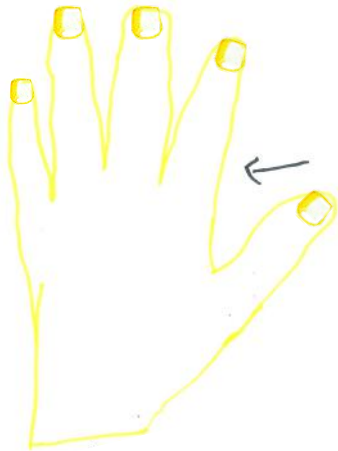




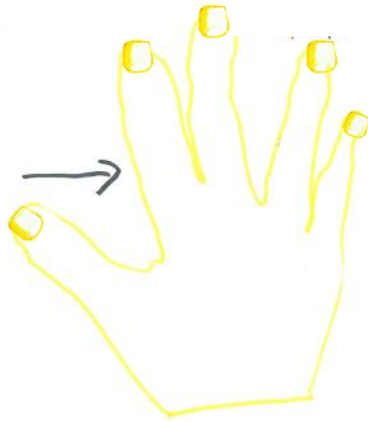
I once met a kid with a wart on his nose.

while others are right.



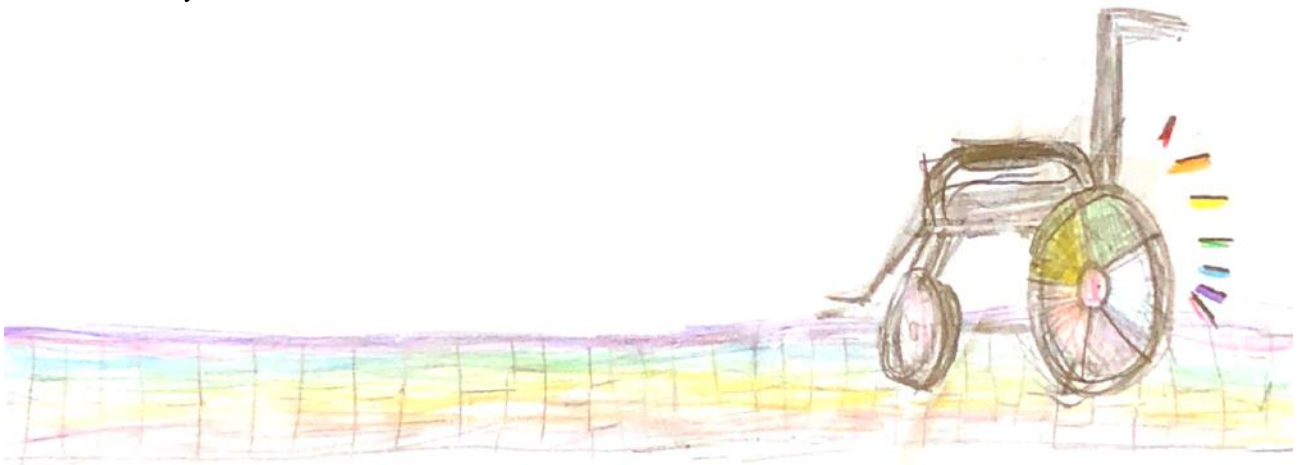
There are kids who can't see,

Kids that can't hear,

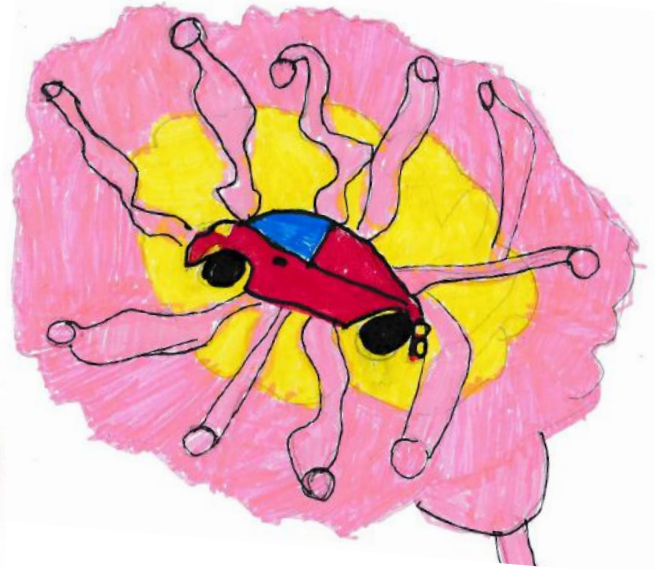


and those who can't walk.
